“Learning In Fellowship Together (L.I.F.T)-Embracing Care Leavers as Change Makers” is a one-year program, focused on developing and nurturing Care Leavers in India as agents of change, who will further the cause of improving the overall situation of Care Leaving in India.

Initiated by Udayan Care, with support from UNICEF, this first ever Fellowship of its kind in India, known as a Fellowship for Care Leavers

Financial Support: A monthly fellowship stipend to meet living and fellowship expenses

Learning and Development: Benefit from a customised curriculum designed to fulfil the needs of young professionals today.

Experiential Learning: Gain exposure to real-world issues through a self-designed, hands on project, addressing community and/or advocacy issues.

Mentorship: Gain skills and support from a mentorship programme led by prominent industry experts.

Opportunity to create impact: An opportunity for the chosen fellows to mentor the fellows in the following years.



Objectives of Fellowship

1. Enable care leavers to become agents of change to improve Aftercare situation
2. Capacity building of care leavers in life skills and project management skills
3. Empower care leavers to create new opportunities for them in their professional lives
4. Hone leaderships skills in them to transition them into care leaders
5. Strengthen the already exist care leavers networks and establish new care leaver networks in states they don't exist
6. Pair up industry professionals with care leavers to provide mentoring support



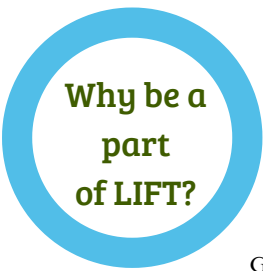
