#### HIV KYA HAI?

HIV - Human Immunodeficiency Virus, is a virus that weakens the immune system, making it harder for the body to fight off infections and diseases.



### PRIMARY INFECTION (ACUTE HIV)

#### Possible signs and symptoms include:

- Fever
- Headache
- Rash
- Cough
- Night sweats
- Diarrhea

- Swollen lymph glands, mainly on the neck
- Muscle aches and joint pain
- Sore throat and painful mouth sores
- Weight loss

#### AIDS KO SAMJHE:

AIDS -Acquired Immunodeficiency Syndrome, is the advanced stage of HIV (Human Immunodeficiency Virus) infection.

## CAUSES OF HIV AND AIDS

#### USE OF CONTAMINATED NEEDLES AND SYRINGES:



Individuals who engage in the sharing of needles, particularly among people who inject drugs, are at a heightened risk of HIV transmission.

Every year - 1 out 300


#### BLOOD AND BLOOD PRODUCT TRANSFUSION:

If the donor's blood is infected with the virus and not properly screened.



#### UNPROTECTED SEXUAL INTERCOURSE: -

Engaging in unprotected sex with an infected person increases the risk of HIV and other STIs entering our body.



<sup>\*</sup>In India, sexual transmission is responsible for **87.4** percent of reported HIV cases ( world bank )

### MOTHER-TO-CHILD TRANSMISSION

- During Pregnancy
- Childbirth
- Breastfeeding



#### PREVENTION OF HIV AND AIDS?

- Regular HIV testing
- Avoid sharing needles or syringes
- Education and awareness
- Access to healthcare
- Safe and protected sex

Treatment of HIV

A.R.T - (Antiretroviral therapy) medicines, which work by stopping the virus replicating in the body.



\*In India, in 2022, there were about 1.6 million with HIV who were on antiretroviral treatment (ART). There has been a sharp increase in the number of people on ART since 2005.(statista.com)

#### A.R.T MEDICATION KI JARURAT KO SAMJHE:

- Prevention of HIV Progression to AIDS
- Preservation of Immune Function
- Reduced HIV Transmission Risk
- Enhanced Quality of Life
- Viral Load Suppression
- Extended Lifespan
